

## LA-506 FY 2019 Continuum of Care (CoC) Competition Timeline: Renewal Projects

The following timeline applies to projects eligible for renewal funding in the FY2019 Continuum of Care (CoC) Program Competition. For the purposes of this timeline, a renewal project is defined as a project that was awarded in the FY 2018 competition with an executed grant agreement by December 31, 2019.<sup>1</sup> Specific dates listed below are subject to change at the Northlake Homeless Coalition's (NHC) discretion and will be published on <http://northlakehomeless.org/coc-applications>.

<b>July 3</b>	Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) is released for the Fiscal Year (FY) 2019 Continuum of Care Program Competition
<b>July 11</b>	Project Applications are available in e-snaps
<b>July 22</b>	Renewal Project Supplemental Application published
<b>July 24</b>	FY 2020 NHC draft partnership agreements sent to all CoC-funded applicants <sup>2</sup>
<b>August 7</b>	Deadline to submit proposed changes to NHC draft partnership agreements
<b>August 12</b>	Revised NHC partnership agreements sent to all CoC-funded applicants (if revisions are required)
<b>August 14</b>	NHC Providers and Stakeholders Association informational meeting regarding the FY2019 CoC Competition
<b>August 19</b>	Draft Community Benchmarks Scorecard sent to each project
<b>August 19 - 30</b>	HMIS data cleanup and HMIS/CoC office hours to address any data issues affecting scorecards
<b>August 21</b>	Deadline to submit Project Application (in e-snaps) and Renewal Project Supplemental Application
<b>August 30</b>	Deadline to make any corrections to HMIS data affecting tabulation of scorecards
<b>September 5</b>	Community Benchmarks Scorecards finalized and published to the NHC Website
<b>September 9</b>	Deadline to submit signed NHC Partnership Agreements.
<b>September 12</b>	Community Evaluation Meeting to review and rank projects
<b>September 13</b>	Projects notified in writing as to whether project was accepted, reduced or rejected.
<b>September 18</b>	Project Priority listing announced and published to the NHC website.
<b>September 20</b>	All project applications finalized in e-snaps
